# ScoutLook

Is a wilderness camp geared for Scouting youth aged 10 –12 years of age and

have had little backcountry camping exposure. That would be Wolf Cubs that have just leaped up or will be leaping up to Scouts, and 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year Scouts.

Camp Alloway is located on the south shore of Big Whiteshell Lake and is accessible only by boat. There is no plumbing or electricity, and water is transported in or filtered on site.

The camp program focuses on camping skills, canoeing skills, and Leave No Trace - outdoor ethics. Specific activities include, water safety, first aid, canoe skills, knots and lashing, operating cooking equipment, tent assembly, preparing and clean up of meals assigned, and crafts.

There will be two levels of activities this year as we will be having a group return for a second year and those attending for the first year. The returning campers will be focusing on preparing for and executing an overnight adventure.

Due to size of the camp area and staffing there is limited number of spaces. 24 spaces in each level, total of 48 campers.

ScoutLook is also for any Scouters (from any section) who would like to learn about backcountry camping or just would like to get out camping with the youth.

Our goal is to introduce camping skills to both the youth and adult members.

The more comfortable our adult members are getting outside and camping the greater experiences we can offer our youth members. So come and join us and expand your skills to provide outdoor events for your youth.

Pre-camp event(s) will be held to educate and prepare the participants for camp. These pre-camp dates will also be for mom and/or dad to be informed and learn about the equipment and how to support your Scouting youth in this adventure.

Participants will be responsible for their own transportation to Big Whiteshell Lake. Car-pooling with other participants is encouraged. Parents can meet to organize this on the pre-camp date.

A detailed registration package and equipment list will be mailed out / e-mailed after registration and payment of the deposit has been received.
